Contact with us

Cookies

Our website uses so-called cookies. These are small text files that are stored on your device using the browser. These files will not do any damage.

We use cookies to make our website user-friendly. Some cookies remain stored on your device until you delete them. They enable us to recognize your browser the next time you visit us.

If you do not wish this, you can set your browser so that it informs you whenever cookies may be stored, and you can choose only to allow this in specific cases.

When cookies are deactivated, the functionality of our website may be limited.

Your Rights

You are entitled to information, correction, deletion, restriction, revocation and objection.

If you believe that the processing of your data violates data protection law or your data protection rights have otherwise been violated in any way, you can complain to the supervisory authority. In Austria, this is the "Datenschutzbehörde" (Data Protection Authority).
